When I first started working for MCET Ltd, one of the first learners I came in contact with, was 'Qurban Ali', an elderly gentleman of 70 years, with a religious appearance. I remember thinking what a quiet and shy-like person he was, that didn't have a lot to say, but was very respectful to others, the kind of person you would say hello to while passing.

Qurban came to us to improve his numeracy skills to a 'level 2', which is the requirement for the 'Electrical Maintenance' course which he is attending currently.

After being enrolled onto the numeracy course he proceeded with enthusiasm and a care for the finest details, that's become his trademark with this centre.

Qurban completed his 'Numeracy level 1', but sometimes that jump to the next level can be a very difficult hurdle to over come. To bridge that gap we had to enrol him onto various build-up courses such as "Numbers Direct – Handling Data and Shapes and Measures" courses that are aimed at developing the weaker areas of any subject the learner may have difficulty with.

During those difficult times in his learning, 'Qurban' developed as a person, because learning is about communication, the better you communicate with others, the greater potential there is to learn and for Qurban this was so.

In the nicest possible way the new open, chatty, confident and forthcoming Qurban has become more than a learner. His ability to see things, has developed with his ability too learn, and learn he has.

Numeracy level 2 has been followed up with ECDL 1, and all this has been achieved by a man who has not been



afraid to begin to learn all over again.

Talking to him about our centre, Qurban said, "To come to the centre in the morning or night, knowing that there is always someone to help me when I need it, has encouraged me to continue when I might have stopped. The fact, I can attend at my convenience suits me just fine."

We at MCET have taken the first steps in developing the ITQ course at our centres.


Following discussion with the 'Learndirect' we were given a target of 10 learners, that would be enrolled and go on to achieve their ITQ's.


